Doors and windows can cost a bundle, or you can pay the right price for the right performance. Our standard selections are beautiful, functional, and efficient.



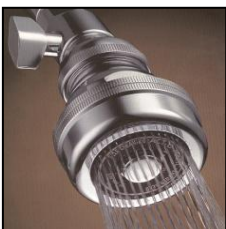
Appliances

With a lot of different trades on site, it's easy to overlook little leaks and gaps that happen: we don't, and that extra attention always pays off in your utility bills.



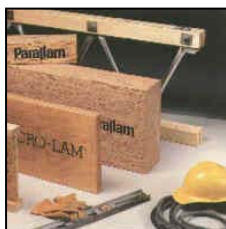
Fixtures
